

## Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capacity, there are actually four sizes of hook type blade carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks may vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
